Marching Together designed by Mosey 'N Me for Kreinik

Stitch on 28-ct Ice Blue Zweigart Cashel Linen from Norden Crafts. This design is stitched over two threads; each square on the chart equals two fabric threads. When stitching with Silk Mori or Anchor Embroidery Floss, use two strands. When stitching with metallic braid, use one strand. (There are a few exceptions.) The Flag Pole is worked in a Diagonal Satin Stitch and is worked with 3 threads of Anchor 379. There is a touch of white in all of the children's eyes using 1 strand of Mori 8000. The flag bearer's hat is back-stitched with two strands Mori 5093. His pocket is backstitched with two strands Mori 8000. His hair and mouth are two strands of Mori 3017. The little drummer's lips are two strands Mori 3044. Her drumstick is two strands Anchor 379. The dog has French/Colonial Knot eyes that are two strands of Mori 8050. His collar is 1 strand #4 Braid 421. The third child has a French/Colonial Knot mouth which is two strands of Mori 3017. The wagon pull string is one strand of #4 Braid 421, with a French/Colonial Knot at the end of the string. On the wagon's wheels are large cross stitches (cover four threads) that were stitched on top of the regular cross stitches and use two strands of Mori 8000.



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
