- 12" x 12" Unfinished Frame
- 12" x 12" Sheet Metal*
- 12" x 12" Calendar Transparency
- Assorted Papers & Embellishments
- Clipart (see page 2)
- i-top Brad Maker Tool #001309
- Large Magnet Daddies #002180
- Paint
- Diamond Glaze, Judikins



This project features the new i-top magnet daddies.

Instructions

- 1. Paint wood part of frame any color acrylic you desire.
- 2. Place "Calendar Transparency" behind glass.
- 3. Place "Sheet Metal" behind transparency, glass and close back of frame. *NOTE: If you're not sure where to purchase sheet metal from, most heating/cooling shops will cut metal to size for a very minimal cost.
- 4. Punch the clipart (page 2) using the large i-top punch.
- 5. Use i-top tool and large magnet daddies to create calendar magnets. To learn how to use the i-top tool, visit our website to watch how-to videos on the tool and more fun projects.
- 6. Once you've created your magnets, coat them with a thin layer of Diamond Glaze by Judkins. It protects the clipart and also makes them shinny.
