To make these whimsical delights all you need is a bit of fabric, a pair of scissors, a bit of stuffing, some ribbon, and kind of embellishment that you might want to use to decorate these lovelies with!

Really, the sky is the limit; it all depends on what you like and what you are going to be using them for.



supplies needed for 1 star:

12 inches of fabric, stuffing, sewing machine, thread, ribbon, beads, embellishments, glue, pins, and safety pins

You need to copy, trace and cut out two of the star pattern.

Any fabric is fine; however the fabric that I used was cotton. You then knot and pin your ribbons to the corners and sew the good sides of the fabric together using a machine and leaving a 1 1/2" opening to flip in right side out. After you have done that stuff it up, hand sew the opening and the fun part remains!



Now you can have a **GREAT** time adding all the fun embellishments that you want to it! You can be as creative and whimsical as you what to!!! Enjoy!
