

Think Snow

Stitched on DMC 14-count White Aida.

Use 2 strands of Light Effects or Embroidery Floss (unless otherwise noted) with a Size 24 Tapestry Needle. For combination colors, use 2 strands of Light Effects and 1 strand of Embroidery Floss worked together.

Design Area: 80 stitches wide x 83 stitches high.

For Back Stitch:

- 911 Medium Emerald Green
- 3837 Ultra Dark Lavender

Use 1 strand of Light Effects color #E301 for bow behind bell, clothesline, writing on sign; #E130 for hat, scarf, vest, bow at ear, stripes on patch; #E5200 for snowflake on mitten.

Use 1 strand of Embroidery Floss color #801 for eyes, nose and mouth; #3325 for snow; #911 for inside green mitten; #3837 for inside lavender mitten. Backstitch outside of all mittens in color used for cross stitching. Use #433 for all other backstitch, and for French knots on small snowman.

Add single straight stitch to center of eyes as shown on chart in color #E5200.
