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








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Sparkling New Years Card by Margie Higuchi

Putting together a New Year's card is easy with the **E-Z Runner® Grand Permanent Strips Refillable Dispenser**. You can dispense Permanent Strips in long lines, curves, and even as individual strips with this lightweight and versatile dispenser. It's easy and economical to refill, with four options for drop in refill cartridges.

Supply List

Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L®: E-Z Runner® Grand Permanent Strips Refillable Dispenser, 3D Foam Holiday Embellishment Kit

Cardstock: Shimmery Navy, Silver Mirror

White Vellum

Paints: White Paint

Other: Water Mister, Paint Brush, Computer Font

or Stamp

Creative Time: 45 minutes

- 1. Fold a piece of 8 ½ x 5 ½-inch shimmery navy cardstock in half to make a vertical 4 ¼ x 5 ½-inch card base. Set aside.
- 2. Cut one 4 x 5½-inch with white vellum.
- 3. On a scrap piece of wax paper, squeeze a drop of white acrylic paint and add water with a water mister for a watery consistency. Dip a medium fine tip paint brush into the mixture and tap the brush with your other hand to make paint splatters on your vellum card panel in a diagonal line from corner to corner. Set aside to dry.



 Die-cut a 3 ¼-inch wide star from silver mirror cardstock. On its back, apply strips of E-Z Runner® Grand Permanent Strips Refillable adhesive and place on the vellum card panel.

Designer's Tip: The **E-Z Runner® Grand Permanent Strips Refillable Dispenser** is easy to use on my projects. No more switching between multiple adhesives. I can dispense adhesive strips long or short in tight areas like the star die cuts.

5. Place the silver star die cut on the vellum card panel.



 From the 3D Foam Holiday Embellishment Kit, use 3D Foam Stars and silver and blue craft foils. Randomly place the small 3D Foam Star shapes onto the vellum card panel, keep the top liner on for easy handling.



 Remove the top liner on one of the 3D Foam Stars, place the blue craft foil (colored side UP) onto the exposed adhesive, and gently rub with finger to transfer the foil color to the star.



8. Slowly remove the foil for a beautiful sparkly star!



- 9. Repeat the process for the other stars using your choice of blue or silver craft foils.



11. Die-cut a 1½-inch wide star with shimmery navy cardstock. Apply E-Z Runner® Grand Permanent Strips Refillable adhesive behind each piece and place on card panel. Note: See how I applied the adhesive strips individually as needed, on the navy star die cut.

12. Apply **E-Z Runner® Grand Permanent Strips** adhesive behind each element on the vellum card panel and center onto the card base to finish.





Owl Always Love You Card

Whooo doesn't love owls? This adorable owl features layers of **Creative Photo Corners** as the owl's feathers! Simple shapes make it easy to cut and create this handsome Valentine.

Supply List

Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L®: E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser Creative Photo Corners Kraft 3D Foam Squares White Regular Size

Patterned Paper: Jillibean Soup

Dies: Spellbinders Classic Circles SM, Classic Circles LG, Classic Hearts, 6 x 6 Matting Basics

Ink: Ranger Ink Distress Ink Walnut Stain

Cardstock: White, Black, Peach, Grey, Kraft, Red

Creative Time: 30 minutes



 Cut multiple circles with dies from kraft cardstock.



2. Select the largest circle die and use it to cut and create a moon shape and oval. This will be the owl's body and wing.



3. Ink the edges of the Creative Photo Corners Kraft.



4. Starting at the bottom of the moon shape, apply **Creative Photo Corners Kraft**, building the design upwards.



 Continue to work up the left-hand side of the moon shape and trim the Creative Photo Corners Kraft at the curved edge if necessary. Cut a second oval to use as the other wing. Ink the edges of the ovals.



6. Attach one wing to the right-hand side with **3D** Foam Squares White Regular Size.



7. Attach the second wing behind the body with **3D** Foam Squares White Regular Size.



8. Create the owl's head similarly by cutting a section out of a circle. Cut more circles from black, peach, grey, and white cardstock to create the eyes. Cut peach cardstock with a leaf shape for the nose and a heart shape for the feet. Adhere these using the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser.




 Create the card base from white cardstock and mat patterned paper with the E-Z Runner®
 Grand Refillable Dispenser. Print or stamp a sentiment on white cardstock and adhere to the patterned paper.



10. To finish, attach the owl to card front with E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser and add a small red die cut heart to the Owl's chest with 3D Foam Squares White Regular Size.





St. Patrick Button Shamrock Card by Margie Higuchi

Adding dimension with buttons makes an unexpected and whimsical St. Patrick's Day card. It's easy to adhere small shapes with **Adhesive Dots!**

Supply List

Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L®: Adhesive Dots Small, Crafty Power Tape

Cardstock: White, Green, Bright Green

Buttons: Green, White

Other: Computer Font or stamp

Creative Time: 30 minutes



- 1. Fold a piece of 4 ¼ x 11-inch green cardstock in half to make a vertical 4 ¼ x 5 ½-inch card base.
- 2. Cut two card panels: 4 x 51/8-inch from bright green cardstock and 3 3/4 x 5 -inch with light green cardstock.
- 3. Die-cut or cut a 3 ½ x 2 ¾-inch shamrock shape from green cardstock (the same as card base). This will be the guide for your focal button element of the card.



4. Feed **Adhesive Dots Small** from the dispensing box one by one. Place an Adhesive Dot with its liner on the back of each button. Press the Adhesive Dot, with the liner still on it, into the button. Remove the clear liner and adhere your button to the shamrock die cut.

Designer's Tip: There are nine different sizes and types of Adhesive Dots. I'm using Adhesive Dots Small because most of my buttons were close to this size. Choose the size that works for you. From Adhesive Dots 3D to Adhesive Lines, keep them handy for all your projects.

5. Work your way around the shamrock shape, using different button sizes and colors to cover the shape.



 Layer the two card panels from Step 2 and adhere them with Crafty Power Tape. Using the same adhesive, center the layered card panel on to the card base.



7. Adhere the button shamrock shape to the card front with **Crafty Power Tape**.



- 8. Print or stamp "Happy St. Patrick's Day" and a shamrock image onto white cardstock. Trim the sentiment strip, adhere onto bright green cardstock cut to 3 % x 1-inch, with **Adhesive Dots Small** on the back on each end.
- Center a small green button on the shamrock image of sentiment with an Adhesive Dot Small to finish.

Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L®: 3D Foam Easter Shapes,3D Foam Circles White Mix, E-Z Runner® Permanent Strips Refillable Dispenser

Cardstock: Pink, Baby Blue, Green, Yellow, White


Vellum: Plain White Vellum

Stickers: Cardstock Alphabet Stickers


Creative Time: 45 minutes



- Adhere a piece of 10 ¾ x 10 ¾-inch square white cardstock on top of a piece of 12 x 12-inch blue cardstock with E-Z Runner® Permanent Strips Refillable Dispenser.
- 2. Cut seven 2 ½ x 2 ½-inch cardstock squares in different pastel colors.
- 3. Cut a piece of 7 ³/₄ x 7 ³/₄-inch yellow cardstock.
- Adhere these pieces in place along left and bottom of white square cardstock. Leave narrow white borders around the smaller cardstock pieces with E-Z Runner® Permanent Strips Refillable Dispenser.



5. Cut seven 2 ¼ x 2¼-inch squares from plain white vellum.



 Add 3D Foam Easter Shapes to five of the vellum squares. With 3D Foam Circles White in small sizes, add a circle to each corner of the five square vellum pieces. Leave the other two of the vellum pieces blank.



- 7. Remove the liners from the 3D Foam Easter Shapes and 3D Foam Circles. Adhere the vellum squares on top of the small cardstock squares on the layout. The two blank vellum squares will be in the bottom right hand corner of the layout.
- Add the layout title to these two blank vellum squares and adhere straight to the layout with E-Z Runner® Permanent Strips Refillable Dispenser, hiding the adhesive under the letter stickers.

 Add 3D Foam Circles in small sizes to the corners. This time on top of the vellum and do not remove the adhesive liners.



10. Quadruple mat the 4 x 6-inch photo in coordinating cardstock. Adhere the layers using E-Z Runner® Permanent Strips Refillable Dispenser. Adhere the matted photo to the page with 3D Foam Circles White in regular sizes.









Happy Mother's Day Card by Beth Pingry

Die cut intricate shapes and easily add dimension with **3D Foam Creative Sheets**. They feature high-density foam that won't crush, and permanent double-sided adhesive, so you don't have to worry about applying adhesive to tiny bits and pieces.

Creative Time: 30 minutes



1. Create a 4 ¼ x 5 ½-inch card base from oatmeal cardstock.



- Cut a 4 x 5 ¼-inch panel from burgundy cardstock, attach to base with E-Z Squares® Dispenser.
- 3. Cut striped paper to 3 ¾ x 5 ¼-inch, attach to burgundy panel with **E-Z Squares® Dispenser**.
- 4. Cut oatmeal cardstock to 2 ½ x 2 ½-inch, cut burgundy cardstock to 3 ½ x 3 ½-inch. Adhere oatmeal onto burgundy with **E-Z Squares® Dispenser**.
- 5. Trim white **3D Foam Creative Sheets** and patterned paper to 3 x 3-inch. Remove top liner from Creative Sheet and adhere patterned paper.



- 6. Die cut with decorative heart die and remove negative pieces from the die cut.
- 7. Remove back liner from heart die cut, carefully center and adhere to oatmeal square.
- Add Creative Photo Corners Ivory to the corners of the burgundy-oatmeal square. Add E-Z Squares® to the back side of the layered squares and adhere to the striped card panel in the upper third of the card.

Designer's Tip: Creative Photo Corners will hold photos or paper with permanent adhesive, yet no adhesive touches your media. When you use them as an embellishment to hold multiple layers, it's best to secure the layers directly with a permanent adhesive such as **E-Z Squares**®.

 Trim a piece of lace to 4-inch, add Mounting Squares Clear Half-Size to the back side of the lace. Remove the liners and adhere near bottom of striped card panel.





10. Tie a bow with seam binding and ribbon. Add Adhesive Dots Medium to the back side of each, remove liners and adhere over lace at right-hand side of card.





- Adhere 3D Foam Squares Black to backside of each sticker to use as embellishments. Remove the 3D Foam Square liners and adhere stickers into place, creating dimension and interest.






3. Add sequins to card using **Adhesive Dots Small**.







Father's Day Card by Christine Meyer

Celebrate Dad with a fun and easy card! The **E-Z Runner® Micro Refillable Dispenser** is my go-to adhesive for small die cuts, at only ½" wide it can fit onto tiny and intricate pieces! It applies in individual strips, long lines and even on curves.

Creative Time: 30 minutes



- 1. Fold a piece of 6 x 8 ½-inch black cardstock in half to create a horizontal card base.
- 2. Die cut a background design with a craft die from yellow cardstock.




- 3. With the **E-Z Runner® Micro Refillable Dispenser**, apply adhesive to the yellow die cut all the way to the edges.
- 4. Punch the letters DAD with a mini alphabet punch and yellow patterned paper.

- 5. Cut a 4 ½ x 2 ½-inch rectangle from a black and yellow polka dot patterned paper.
- 6. Cut a 4 ¾ x 2 ¾-inch rectangle from an agua cardstock.

pesigner's Tip: Switch the adhesive refills by opening the E-Z Runner Refillable Dispenser, lift out the Micro Refill, and replace with the Permanent Strips Refill, and closing the case. All E-Z Runner Refillable Dispensers work with all the E-Z Runner® Refills, and you can swap them out as desired, even mid-use!

- Mount the black and yellow polka dot rectangle onto the aqua cardstock rectangle with E-Z Runner® Permanent Strips Refill.
- 8. Add a **Creative Photo Corner White** to each corner of the layered rectangle.
- Adhere the layered rectangle to the center of the card base using the E-Z Runner® Permanent Strips Refill.
- 10. Adhere the letters DAD to the patterned paper using **3D Foam Squares Regular**.





Happy 4th of July Star Card by Judy Hayes

Stars are always a good idea for a 4th of July card! Add **Adhesive Sheets** to the back of cardstock before die cutting to make it easy to layer intricate die cuts.

Supply List

Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L®: Adhesive Sheets 4 x 6 inch, E-Z Runner® Micro Refillable Dispenser, Thin 3D Foam Squares White Mix

Dies: Spellbinders® Paper Arts Stars Five,

Filigree Numbers

Stamp: Stampers Anonymous Tim Holtz Crazy Talk

Cardstock: Red, Blue, White, Kraft

Other: Red twine

Creative Time: 30 minutes



- 1. Fold $4\frac{1}{4}$ x 11-inch kraft cardstock in half to form $4\frac{1}{4}$ x $5\frac{1}{2}$ -inch top fold card base. Set aside.
- 2. Apply Adhesive Sheets 4 x 6 inch to back of dark blue and red cardstock by removing the yellow liner and pressing the cardstock into the exposed adhesive.

Designer's Tip: I used **Adhesive Sheets** 4 x 6 inch for this project because all my pieces fit on one. Adhesive Sheets also come in 6 x 12-inch and 12 x 12-inch sizes. They can be punched, fussy cut and die cut in manual and electronic machines.



- 3. Die cut 3½-inch star from dark blue cardstock with Adhesive Sheets on back.
- 4. Die cut number 4 with outer die and filigree insert from red cardstock with Adhesive Sheets on back.
- 5. Die cut number 4 with outer die only from white cardstock.
- 6. Die cut 4-inch star from white cardstock.
- 7. Cut $1\frac{1}{4}$ x $4\frac{1}{4}$ -inch piece of white cardstock.
- 8. Cut ¼ x 4¼-inch strip of red cardstock.
- 9. Cut 3/8 x 41/4-inch strip of blue cardstock.



10. Fasten red and blue strips to white cardstock using **E-Z Runner® Micro Refillable Dispenser**.



11. Stamp verse with black ink.



12. Attach to bottom edge of card using **E-Z Runner**® **Micro Refillable Dispenser**.



- 13. Remove **Adhesive Sheet** liner from blue star and fasten on white star.
- 14. Remove **Adhesive Sheet** liner from red number 4 and fasten to white number 4 slightly offset so white shows on right edge.



15. Attach number 4 to star with **Thin 3D Foam Squares**.



16. Use **Thin 3D Foam Squares** to fasten star to card front.



17. Knot red twine around top fold of card.







Back to School Scrapbook Page

Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L®: E-Z Dots® Permanent Refillable Dispenser, 3D Foam Squares White Regular Size, Adhesive Dots Small

Cardstock: Kraft by Park Lane, Bazzill and American Crafts

Patterned Paper: American Crafts Shimelle Go Now Go Collection

Stickers and Washi Tape: Jillibean soup

Die Cuts: Silhouette Paige Taylor Evans, Sweet Afton

Sequins and Cardstock Embellishments: Pink Paislee Pick Me Up by Paige Taylor Evans

Creative Time: 45 minutes



 Cut two 6 x 6-inch squares from solid cardstock, and 2 from patterned paper. Adhere in opposites corners of the page using the E-Z Dots® Permanent Refillable Dispenser.



 Trim a piece of white cardstock to ¼ x 12-inch and adhere this horizontally across the center with E-Z Dots® Permanent Refillable Dispenser, to cover the seam created by the cardstock squares.



- 3. Add photos, trim or tuck 4 x 6-inch photos so they fit the 6 x 6-inch squares.
- 4. Using a book die, die-cut with white and kraft cardstock.
- 5. Cover the back side of the die cuts with E-Z Dots® Permanent Refillable Dispenser. Fill each 'book' with patterned paper or solid cardstock. Layer this with the kraft die cut to keep all pieces secure. Use 3D Foam Squares adhere the books die cuts to the bottom right corner of the layout.







6. Die cut the title "back to school" with white and kraft cardstock, and layer them staggered to make a shadow effect, using **E-Z Dots**® **Permanent Refillable Dispenser**.





 Add stickers, sequins and journaling to finish the layout. Use 3D Foam Squares White Regular Size to add dimension to otherwise flat items. Use Adhesive Dots Small for sequins and tiny embellishments.





8. Optional: Machine stitch or hand stitch a few lines around the page to add some texture.





"Boo" Halloween Scrapbook Page

Assemble the Patterned Paper Base by cutting patterned papers to: 9 x 9-inch yellow; 6 x 12-inch pink; 8 x 11-inch blue; 7 x 10-inch green. Gather patterned papers in a seasonal color palette. Arrange the cut patterned papers and use the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser with E-Z Runner Grand® Permanent Dots Refill to attach to a 12 x 12-inch piece of black and white patterned paper. Apply an orange cardstock border sticker on the left side of the layout to cover the edges of the patterned papers.



Designer's Tip: To switch refills in the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser, press your thumb on the ridges at the bottom of the case. Open the clear lid, lift up the refill. Add the desired adhesive refill by aligning it with the prongs in the case and closing the lid.

2. Prepare the "BOO" Title Mask using a pair of nonstick scissors to cut a small portion from the left side of two **Adhesive Dots Large Repositionable**. Press the cut Adhesive Dots onto the top center of a small white cardstock tag to form the Letter "B." Place two more uncut **Adhesive Dots Large Repositionable** under the "B" to create two "O's," to spell the word "BOO."



3. Spray mist over the tag and let it dry. Peel off the **Adhesive Dots**. Use a black marker to outline the masked letters. The portions of the tag that were covered by Adhesive Dots will be white and the word "BOO" should be clearly visible.




4. Use the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable
Dispenser with E-Z Runner Grand®
Permanent Dots Refill to adhere the
photo to the bottom left corner of the layout. Add
chipboard, die-cut, and sticker embellishments
around the photo.



5. Use the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable
Dispenser with E-Z Runner Grand®
Permanent Dots Refill to attach the BOO title
tag and a journaling card to the top right corner
of the page. Attach the white felt bow with a strip
of Permanent Dots adhesive across the top of
the tag. Finish by adding cardstock stickers
and/or enamel shapes in contrasting colors.







Document Thanksgiving Memories

Supply List

Patterned Papers: Die Cuts With a View 12 x 12 Stack

Stickers: October Afternoon Mini Market Set

Cardstock: Navy, White

Trim: Silver and White Twine, Ribbons

Flower: Poinsettia Felt Embellishment

Other: Chipboard Elements, Ink Spray Misters,

Washi Tape

Creative Time: 30 minutes

- 1. With a piece of 7 ½ x 12-inch patterned paper, distress the 12-inch sides by scraping along the edge with a scissor blade.
- Adhere it to the middle of a coordinating 12 x 12inch patterned paper to create a layered base with the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser.





3. Next, cut another coordinating 6 x 12-inch patterned paper. Distress the edges the same way as step 1. Adhere it in the center of the page with the **E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser**.



4. Repeat the same distress process with a piece of 9 x 7-inch white cardstock on all four sides before adhering to the page with the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser. On top of the white cardstock, layer a piece of coordinating 8 ½ x 6 ½-inch patterned paper that is distressed on three sides and torn along the bottom edge. Adhere it with the same dispenser.





5. Mat a 5 ½ x 5 ½-inch photo on a piece of 5 ¾ x 5 ¾-inch navy cardstock with the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser. Note the cardstock will be distressed the same way on all three sides with a torn bottom edge. Mount the photo to the right side of the layer with the same dispenser.



6. Use Adhesive Lines to secure the ribbon embellishments by dispensing the Adhesive Lines from the box with its clear liner. Place the Adhesive Lines on the layout where you want to add ribbon. Remove the clear liners and press the ribbon into the Adhesive Lines. Trim excess ribbon and cut a decorative edge on the ends.



 Add alpha stickers on a journaling card, and then place 3D Foam Squares White Mix in regular size on the back before adhering to the left of the matted photo. 8. Attach chipboard and felt flower with **3D Foam Squares White** in Regular size onto the page. Use decorative washi tape as an accent.





- To embellish the journaling card, add one Adhesive Line behind the left corner of the card and loosely wind the twine to create loops. Press into the Adhesive Line to secure
- 10. Unscrew a spray mister applicator and tap it to let a few drops land on each corner of the layout. Avoid getting it on the photo.



Foiled Christmas Present Card

1. With a strip of 11 x 4 ½-inch black cardstock, score in half to a 4 ½ x 5 ½-inch side-fold card base.



2. Cut a 4 x 5 1/4-inch card panel with patterned paper. Center and adhere card panel to front of black card base with E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser and E-Z Runner® Grand Ultra Strong Refill.

Designer's Tip: To switch refills in the **E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser**, press your thumb on the ridges at the bottom of the case. Open the clear lid, lift up the refill. Add the desired adhesive refill by aligning it with the prongs in the case and closing the lid.





 Trim a 2 ½ x 2 ½-inch piece of white 3D Foam Creative Sheet. Remove the bottom liner and adhere to center of card panel. Remove the top liner.



4. Apply a sheet of Gold Foil from the 3D Foam Holiday Embellishment Kit, over the exposed adhesive with the gold side facing up. Gently rub to transfer the foil and then peel away the foil sheet.




5. Cut two 2 ½-inch red ribbon and two ½ x 2 ½-inch strips of black cardstock. Cut a slight angle on one strip as pictured; this strip will be placed to the left of the Christmas Box. Both strips will be used as a shadow effect along the left and bottom edge of the box.



- Apply both strips of ribbon in a criss-cross direction, adhering on top of foiled box, using the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser with E-Z Runner® Grand Ultra Strong Refill.
- Remove the 3D Foam Bow Shape from the 3D Foam Holiday Embellishment Kit, remove the inside pieces as shown. Keep the pieces for use later.



- 8. Adhere to the center of the crossed ribbons. Remove the top liner and apply Red Foil with the red side facing up. Gently rub then peel away the foil sheet. Fit the 3D Foam Bow Shape pieces back into the red bow, remove the top liners and add Gold Foil to them.
- To create shadows, add the angled black cardstock strip to the left side of the gold box, with the angle as shown. Add the other black strip to the bottom edge of the box used with the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser and E-Z Runner® Grand Ultra Strong Refill.
- 10. On a piece of ¾ x 2 ¼-inch black cardstock, add sentiment or a sticker sentiment and place it approximately ½-inch above the foiled gift box embellishment.





Lightly sand the embossed edges using a sanding block. Adhere onto a pre-cut slightly larger white card base using 3D Foam Squares.


- 4. Adhere a double bow to the left of the centre panel, and a flower to the center of the bow.







- 1. Score and fold yellow card stock to 5 \(^3\/_4\) x 5 \(^1\/_4\)-inch card base.
- 2. Adhere a piece of 5 % x 4 %-inch black cardstock using the E-Z Runner® Permanent Strips Dispenser.



3. To create rainbow panel, adhere **Crafty Foam Tape White** in a diagonal pattern on a piece of 5

1/4 x 4 3/4-inch white cardstock. Do not remove top liners. Use watercolors to paint rainbow colors in between the **Crafty Foam Tape White** strips. Let it dry and then splatter with diluted black paint.



4. Trim excess **Crafty Foam Tape White** from rainbow panel with scissors.



 Remove liners from Crafty Foam Tape White strips and sprinkle glitter on top. Shake off excess. Adhere the panel to the black cardstock using Crafty Foam Tape White.



 Stamp a sentiment onto black cardstock, add white embossing powder and heat to emboss. Use a label shape die to cut the sentiment into a shape.






7. Adhere the sentiment to rainbow panel using **Crafty Foam Tape White**.



 Die cut flowers in pinks and leaves in green cardstock. Use E-Z Runner® Permanent Strips Dispenser for bottom petals and leaves. For the top layer of the flowers, use Crafty Foam Tape White.





9. Use **Adhesive Dots Mini** to attach the sequins and the black flower centers.

 Trim white 3D Foam Creative Sheet to 2 ½ x 3-inch. Remove one liner and adhere cardstock to Creative Sheet.
- 3. Trim a piece of black cardstock to 2 ¾ x 3 ½-inch. Trim black **3D Foam Creative Sheet** to 2 ¾ x 3 ½-inch. Remove one liner and adhere cardstock to Creative Sheet.

4. Die-cut with rectangle dies in nesting sizes.



- 5. Remove the back liner from the white rectangle and add Creative Photo Corners Black to each corner. Slightly pinch the edges of the Photo Corners to cup them so they don't catch the adhesive on the Creative Sheet. Position white rectangle centered onto the black rectangle.
- 6. Remove the back liner from the black rectangle and add Creative Photo Corners White to each corner. Slightly pinch the edges of the Photo Corners to cup them so they don't catch the adhesive on the Creative Sheet. Position black rectangle centered but to the top third of the white panel.



7. Wrap a green ribbon near the bottom of the card panel, secure with **Mounting Squares Clear** at both ends. Trim ribbon edges to fit card panel.



8. Trim a piece of black **3D Foam Creative Sheet** to ½ x 2-inch. Remove top liner and cover with black glitter.

Designer's Tip: I use coffee filters for glitter, they are perfectly sized for most applications, they don't get static electricity charged, and they make it easy to pour glitter back into the jar when done.

- 9. Stamp "Congratulations" onto white cardstock with black ink. Trim a piece of white 3D Foam Creative Sheet to the size of the white stamped piece. Remove top liner and adhere paper to Creative Sheet piece. Now trim the Creative Sheet + sentiment close to the sentiment. Remove the back liner and adhere over the glittered piece.
- Remove the back liner from the black glittered piece and center over the ribbon on the card panel.
- 11. Stamp cactus and pot images onto white cardstock with green ink. Color with markers. Trim with scissors and match up desired cactus with pot. On the back side, adhere the pieces together with **Mounting Squares White** to overlap both pieces. Add additional Mounting Squares as size dictates.



12. Remove the liners from the stamped cactus and pot, adhere in the center of the white rectangle panel.





- 3. Adhere the patterned die cut over cardstock die cut using **E-Z Runner**® **Micro Refillable Dispenser**.



- 4. Fill 2 x 2-inch **Keepsake Envelope** with sequins and seed beads.
- 5. Take off the small liner in the front and fold over the flap to seal the envelope.
- Remove the back liner of the Keepsake
 Envelope and adhere to a piece of 2 x 2-inch patterned paper. Note: make sure the desired patterned side is showing through the envelope.
- 7. Add a line of **E-Z Runner® Micro Refillable Dispenser** across the top front of the envelope and place it behind the Polaroid Frame die cut.



- 1. Cut white cardstock to 3 ½ x 5-inch rectangle, and green cardstock to 3 ¾ x 5 ¼-inch rectangle.
- Remove the yellow liner from an Adhesive Sheet 4 x 6 inch and place the white rectangle on top of the exposed adhesive. Place the yellow liner back on and gently burnish to transfer the adhesive to the paper evenly. Trim excess. Tip: use the excess (unused adhesive) for another project.



 Remove the white Adhesive Sheet liner from the white cardstock to expose the edge-to-edge coverage of adhesive. Pour embossing powder over the exposed adhesive, covering it completely.





 Gently push the powder into the adhesive to secure before shaking off any excess embossing powder.



5. Melt the embossing powder with a heating tool.



6. Attach the green rectangle to a 4 x 5 ½-inch white card base with the **E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser**. Then mat the embossed sheet onto the green rectangle.



7. Stamp the "thank you" sentiment on washi tape. Place the washi across the bottom of the embossed paper.

Designer's Tip: Use the yellow liner from the **Adhesive Sheet** to hold the washi tape flat while stamping the letters.





8. Attach Fairy Die Cut with the E-Z Runner® Grand Refillable Dispenser onto the embossed panel.



Designer's Tip (see top of opposite column):

- 3. Adhere the panel to a piece of 4 ¾ x 6 ¼-inch white cardstock.
- 4. Cut white ribbon about one inch wider than the card. Wrap the ribbon around the card front and adhere the ends behind the white panel using the *E-Z Runner*® *Permanent Strips Refillable Dispenser*.



- 5. Adhere the panel to a grey card base that is slightly larger than the white card panel.
- Print or stamp a sentiment and cut it into a banner using scissors. Adhere 3D Foam Squares Small Size to the back, remove the liners and adhere to the ribbon.
- 7. Make a satin bow and adhere to the card using the E-Z Runner® Permanent Strips Refillable Dispenser.
- 8. Finish the card by adding self-adhesive rhinestones and pearls to the card.
