## Mesh Dishcloth Crochet Pattern

Crochet a mesh dishcloth out of a produce bag! This easy crochet dishcloth pattern works up quickly because of the thick mesh, and it'll work wonders scrubbing pans!



Skill Level: Easy


Finished Size: About 7 inches in diameter.

Gauge: not critical for this project.

## **Materials List**

- 1 mesh produce bag
- L crochet hook
- Scissors

## Pattern



- 1. Cut the mesh produce bag into 1 1/2" strips. Note: depending on the thickness of the mesh, you may be able to keep the width closer to just 1". Use the image above as a reference for how to cut the bag to maximize your material with the fewest joins.
- 2. Ch 4 and sl st in 1st st to form a ring.
- 3. Ch 2 (counts as first dc), 15 dc in ring (16 dc total). Join.
- 4. Ch 2, then 2 dc in each space (of dc from row before, 32 dc total). Join.
- 5. Fasten off, weave in ends.
