## **Special Stitches:**

**popcorn:** 5 dc in space indicated, remove hook from stitch, insert hook into top of first dc, replace free loop, and draw through first dc.

flp: Front Loop blp: Back Loop

middle bar: Horizontal bar made by yarn over under top two

oops

**picot**: Ch 4, sl st to top of prev dc (insert in front loop and one

strand on post of stitch)

**FPsc**: Insert hook from front to back to front around post of stitch indicated and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through loops on hook.

#### **Stitches Used:**

ch Chain
sl st Slip Stitch
sc Single Crochet
hdc Half Double Crochet
dc Double Crochet
tr Treble Crochet
tch Turning Chain
ch-sp Chain Space

#### Gauge:

Blossom = 3" dia Crocus = 2" dia Iris = 3" dia Victoria = 3.5" dia Cornflower = 4" dia


#### **Blossom Flower**

A: #1406 Parrot, 4 yds B: #1403 Royal Plum, 8 yds

Make an adjustable ring with A.

**Rnd 1** Ch 3, 4 dc in ring, remove hook from st, insert hook in top of tch, replace free loop from st and draw through, \*ch 4, popcorn in ring; rep from \* 4 more times, ch 4, sl st to top of tch, fasten off, do not turn. (6 popcorn)

**Rnd 2** Join B with sl st in same st, ch 1, [sc, dc, 5 tr, dc, sc] in ea ch-4 sp, around, sl st to first sc, fasten off, weave in ends. (30 tr)





A: #1406 Parrot, 2 yds B: #1409 Sunshine, 2 yds C: #1403 Royal Plum, 3 yds

Make an adjustable ring with A.

Rnd 1 Ch 2 (counts as hdc throughout), 11 hdc in ring, pull ring closed, sl st to top of tch, turn. (12 hdc)

Rnd 2 Join C to top of tch, ch 2, \*2 hdc flp in next hdc\*\*, hdc flp in next hdc; rep from \* around ending with \*\*, sl st to top of tch, do not turn. (18 hdc)

Rnd 3: \*3 sc blp in next hdc, sl st blp in next hdc; rep from around, fasten off B, do not turn. (27 sc)

Rnd 4: Join B to middle ch of tch of Rnd 2 with sl st, ch 2, hdc in middle bar of ea hdc around, sl st to top of tch, fasten off, weave in ends. (12 hdc)

Note: Rnd 4 not shown on diagram.



#### **Iris Flower**


A: #1402 Golden Ray, 7 yds B: #1408 Sky Blue, 2 yds

With B, ch 7, sl st to first ch to form ring.

Rnd 1 Ch 2, 17 hdc in ring, sl st to top of tch, fasten off B, do not turn. (18 hdc)

Rnd 2 Join A to tch with sl st, \*ch

5, 3 dc in middle bar of next hdc, picot, 3 dc in middle bar of next hdc, ch 5, sl st in middle bar of next hdc; rep from \* around, fasten off, weave in ends. (6 petals)






#### Victoria Flower

A: #1403 Royal Plum, 2 yds B: #1405 Flamingo, 2 yds C: #1406 Parrot, 6 yds D: #1402 Golden Ray, 6 yds

Make an adjustable ring with A.

- Rnd 1 Ch 3, 15 dc in ring, pull ring closed, sl st to top of tch, fasten off A, do not turn. (16 dc)
- Rnd 2 Join B to top of tch, ch 1, sc in tch, \*ch 3\*\*, sk 1 dc, sc in next dc; rep from \* around ending at \*\*, sl st to first sc, do not turn. (8 ch-sps)
- Rnd 3: Ch 1, \*[sc, ch 1, 4 dc, ch 1, sc] in next ch-sp, Rep from \* around, sl st to first sc, fasten off B, do not turn. (8 petals)
- **Rnd 4:** Join C, ch 1, \*sc between 2 petals, ch 4; rep from \* around, sl st to first sc, do not turn.
- **Rnd 5:** Ch 1, \*[sc, ch 1, 5 dc, ch 1, sc] in next ch-sp, Rep from \* around, sl st to first sc, fasten off C, do not turn.
- **Rnd 6:** Join D to any sc on Rnd 2, ch 1, \*FPsc around sc, ch 2; rep from \* around, sl st to first sc, do not turn.
- **Rnd 7:** \*[Sl st, 3 sc, sl st] in next ch-sp, Rep from \* around, fasten off, weave in ends.





#### **Cornflower Flower**


A: #1402 Golden Ray, 4 yds B: #1409 Sunshine, 6 yds C: #1403 Royal Plum, 8 yds

Make an adjustable ring with A.

- Rnd 1 Ch 2, 11 hdc in ring, pull ring closed, sl st to top of tch, do not turn. (12 hdc)
- Rnd 2 \*Ch 7, sk 4 ch, sl st in next 3 ch, sl st flp in next hdc; rep from \* around, fasten off A, do not turn. (12 petals)
- Rnd 3: Join B to tch on Rnd 1, \*ch 9, sk 5 ch, sc in next 4 ch, sl st blp in next hdc; rep from \* around, fasten off B, do not turn.



Rnd 4: Join C to tch on Rnd 1, \*ch 11, sk 6 ch, hdc in next 5 ch, sl st in middle bar of next hdc; rep from \* around, fasten off, weave in ends.



## **Project Ideas**

#### Flower Pins

Using a hot glue gun, adhere a pin to the back of the flower. Pin onto any outfit to brighten your day.

#### Wreath

Make a number of flowers in coordinating colors. Cover a foam florist wreath with flowers, pin in place.

#### **Artwork**

Cover a canvas with fabric and staple in place. Using spray adhesive, glue flowers to canvas.

#### **Jewelry**

Make flower with thread instead of yarn. Join to necklace chain or earring back with jump rings to make quick jewelry.

#### Hair Clip

Using a hot glue gun, adhere a hair clip to the back of the flower.

#### Cardigan Collar

Sew flowers to collar of cardigan.
