

Brioche Make up Remover

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<u>Size:</u> 3" x 3.5"

Skill Level: Advanced Beginner or Intermediate

Skills Used: Basic Knitting, slipped stitches, decreases

<u>Materials:</u>

One skein Berroco "Pima 100" (100% Pima Cotton) in a dark color (DC)
 One skein Berroco "Pima 100" (100% Pima Cotton) in a dark color (LC)
 Size US 4/3.5mm circular knitting needles (two for class)
 Locking stitch marker - have a couple handy
 Yarn needle or large embroidery needle

Gauge: 6 sts and 8 rows to 1" on 1x1 Rib before blocking

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Abbreviations/Terms/Techniques:
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Bo = Bind off
Brk = Bark or Brioche Knit - knit the stitch and yarnover together
Brp = Burp or Brioche purl - purl the stitch and yarnover together
Co = Cast on
Cont = Continu(ation)(e)(ed)(es)(ing)
Dc = Dark Color
Ds = Dark Side
\mathbf{G} = \operatorname{Gram}(s)
K = Knit
Lc = Light Color
Ls = Light Side
P = Purl
Patt(s) = Pattern(ed)(ing)(s)
Rep(s) = Repeat(ed)(ing)(s)
Slwyif = slip the next stitch purlwise with the yarn held to the front of the work
SIYOF = the yarn is already to the front of your work, slip the next stitch purlwise then wrap the
right hand needle with the yarn taking it over the needle and back to the front ready to work the
next stitch as if to purl.
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Yf sl yo = Bring the yarn, between the needles, to the front of your work, slip the next stitch
purlwise, work next stitch maintaining the yarn over.
Yf sl1 yof = Bring the yarn, between the needles, to the front of your work, slip the next stitch
purlwise, now wrap yarn all the way around the right hand needle back to the front ready to work
the next stitch as if to purl.
Directions Single Color Brioche:
With LC, co 18 sts.
Ribbing Section:
Work 2 - 4 Rows: K1, (k1, p1) rep to last st, slwyif.
Work 4 rows or more if you are very new to brioche or struggle to see patterns.
Single Color Brioche Section: With LC
Set up Row: K1, (k1, yfslyo) rep to last st, slwyif.
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Brioche Row: K1, (Brk, yfsl1yo) rep to last st, slwylf. Work Brioche Row for 3" or desired length.

Set up for Ribbing: K1, (brk, p1) rep to last st, slwif. Work 1 – 3 rows of ribbing – the last row before bind-off, knit the last st. Bind off in pattern.

Two Color Brioche Directions:

Two color brioche has a light side and a dark side – designated by the knit stitches in each color. Each row is worked twice on each side. Edge sts are only worked in dc. Drop the LC yarn to the back of the work and DC yarn to the front of the work at the end of each row.

With the dark color yarn, cast on 19 stitches and work as follows: Row 1: K1, (k1, p1) rep to last 2 sts, k1, sl1wyif. Row 2: K1, (p1, k1) rep to last 2 sts, p1, rep to last st, sl1wyif. Work Rows 1 & 2 once or twice more.

Two Color Brioche: Drop Lc to back and Dc to front of work. Set Up Rows: LS: W/Lc, slwyif, (k1, yfslyo) rep to last 2 sts, k1, slwyib, and slide sts. LS: W/Dc, k1, yfslyof, (brp, slyof) rep to last st, slwyif. Turn.

Brioche:

DS Row 1: W/Lc, slwyif, (brp, slyof) rep to last 2 sts, brp, sl1wyib, and slide
sts.
DS Row 2: W/Dc, K1, (yfslyo, brk) rep to last 2 sts, yfslyof, slwyif. Turn.
LS Row 1: W/Lc, slwyif, (brk, yfslyo) rep to last 2 sts, brk, slwyib, and slide
sts.
LS Row 2: W/Dc, k1, yfslyof, (brp, slyof) rep to last st, slwyif. Turn.
Rep last 4 Rows for approximately 3" then work the DS rows one more time.

Set up Row for Ribbing: W/ LS facing, using DC: K1, (brk, p1) rep to last 2 sts, brk, slwyif. Turn. W/ DS facing, using DC: K1 (p1, k1) rep to end. (work same number of rib rows as beginning).

Binding off: Work the stitches as they appear and bind off in the normal fashion of pulling one worked stitch over another.

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
